

Greetings!

Fire Extinguisher | We all know we need them but how many of us actually have them in our home? A fire extinguisher can help prevent major fires and will come in handy when you least expect it. Did you know that there are different types of fire extinguishers depending on the cause of the fire? Make sure you have the right kind for your home by checking out this list!


