

This month, I wanted to give some thoughts on something we deal with all the time up here in the mountains; sloped lots.

There are a lot of misconceptions and questions that arise when it comes to a sloped lot and the advantages and disadvantages that come with building a home on one. Either way, the best thing you can do as a homeowner is to gather as much information as possible so that you can make the best decision for you regarding where to build your home. Without further ado, here are some pros and cons of building on a sloped lot!

Pro: The Views | One of the most common advantages, and why many people end up moving to the High Country is for the gorgeous views of the surrounding mountains. Sloped lots can provide the opportunity for unobstructed views of the surrounding area.

Con: Added Costs | Building on a sloped lot means that parts of the construction and development process can be more costly than building on flat land. For example, retaining walls are needed to keep the soil in place and transporting things like materials can be more complicated if the lot is not as easily accessible as a flat lot.

Pro: Walkout Basements | A sloped lot provides the opportunity for more space and square footage options for your home such as basements and even more access to great views with walkout basements. Instead of the typical darkness of an underground basement, a walkout basement allows more daylight to come into your home throughout.

Con: Erosion | Erosion is always something to consider when building on a sloped lot. You'll want to work with your contractor or architect on designs that can help neutralize erosion.


